- 2.4 **Internships and Placement of Students:** Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the Internship and placement of students of the First Party into internships/jobs, as per CCS University Meerut /UP Board (Hindi/English medium)/ Institution / internship Policy.
- 2.5 **Research and Development:** Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities if required in the fields of Education.
- 2.6 **Skill Development Programs:** Both the Parties train the students of each others. First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them employable ready.
- 2.7 **Guest Lectures:** Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements & vice versa.
- 2.8 **Faculty Development Programs:** Second Party to train the Faculties of First Party & Vice versa for imparting exposure/ training as per the educational requirement considering the CCSU/Any other University/Higher Education Institutes/ UP Board/ CBSE/ ICSE/ Any other State board in concerned sector.
- 2.9 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and coordination of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein
- 2.10 There is no financial commitment on the part of the, **SHRI MADHAV COLLEGE OF EDUCATION AND TECHNOLOGY HAPUR** the First Party to take up any program mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

CLAUSE 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppels or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

Any act on the part of Training Partner, the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU.
- 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

CLAUSE 5 RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

- 5.1 It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership.
